*Eklipse aims to establish and follow an ethical infrastructure for all its main activities, thus strengthening the recognition and transparency of its processes. As such, Eklipse's ethical infrastructure builds on many lessons learned from other interface processes, scientific quality assurance and engagement issues coming from transdisciplinary research.*

The form has been developed based on a review of existing documents with the same intention from other organisations. This includes the Conflict of Interest policies of BiodivERSA (for evaluation of proposals), UNEP (a general CoI policy) and IPCC and IPBES (both for experts engaging in their work). As IPBES in its approach is closely related to the work of Eklipse in this area, the form is based strongly on the according IPBES form*

We do not ask for comprehensive lists of activities under each heading set out below. You should disclose interests that are relevant and relate or have the appearance of relating to your role in Eclipse work by:

1. Impairing your objectivity in carrying out your work
2. Creating an advantage for you, your family, close relatives, personal friends or organisation in which you have been working.

For the purposes of this policy, circumstances that could lead a reasonable person to question your objectivity, or whether an advantage has been created, constitute a potential conflict of interest and should be disclosed on this form. Disclosure of interest in this form does not automatically mean that a conflict exists or that you will be unable to perform your designated role in Eclipse. If you are in any doubt about whether an interest should be disclosed, you are encouraged to disclose such interests to the Eclipse Management Body, so it can be checked by the head of the Eclipse Management Body, the Knowledge Coordination Body (KCB) and/or Strategic Advisory Board (SAB).
